I said, "This must be your dad before you existed!"





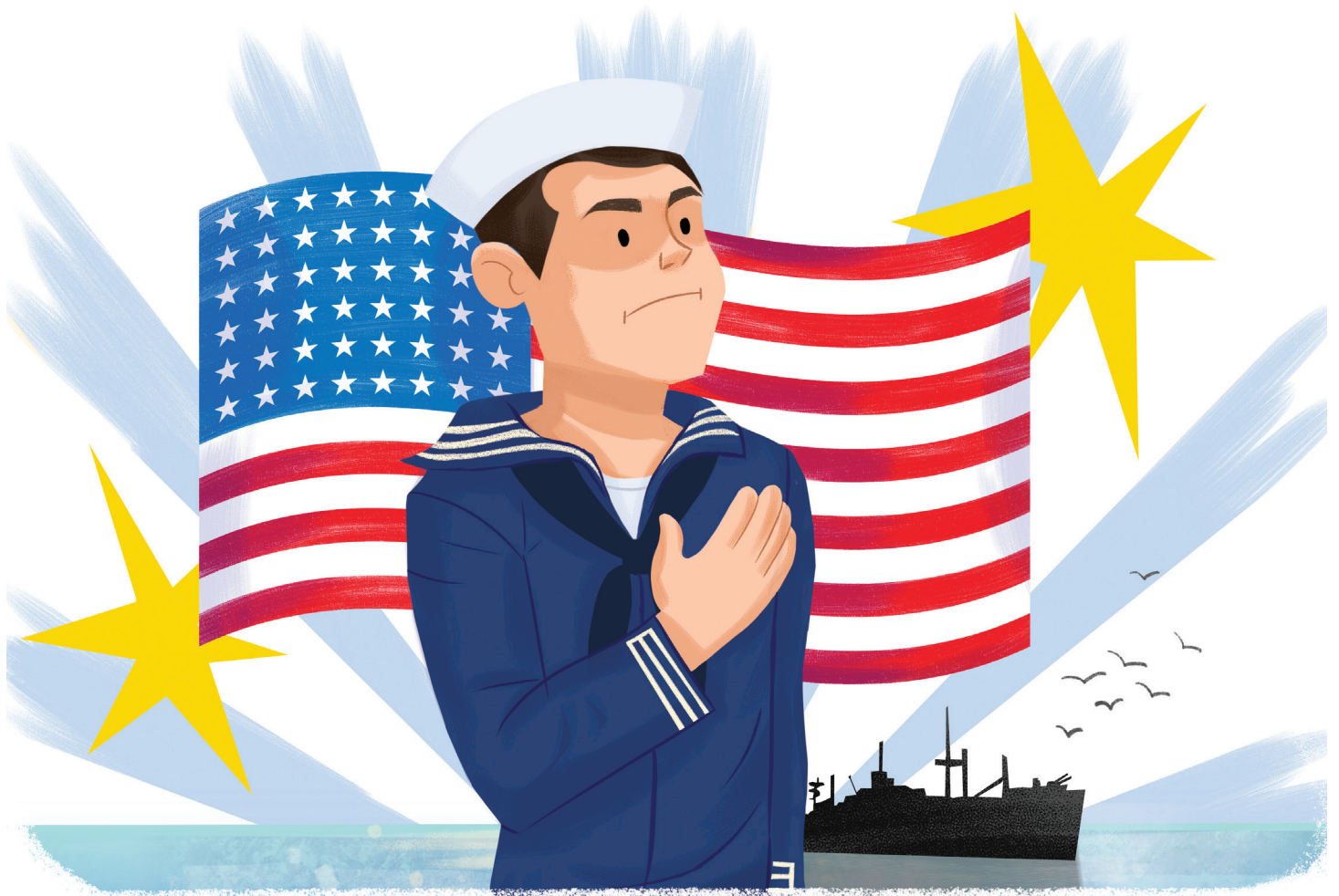
We saw Max Prager hard at work just then.

You work hard to provide for us, and for Otto too!”

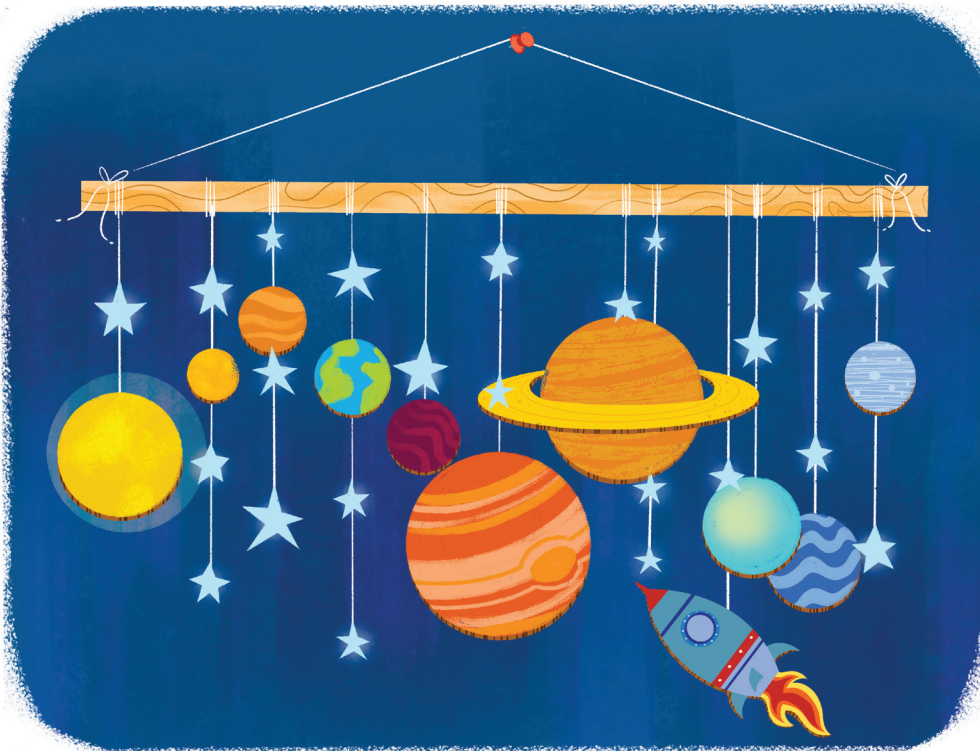
I barked, “You fought hard in the war so we could be free.”

“Well, I never thought I’d see your dad when he was younger. He’s done so much for us, even years before you were born!”

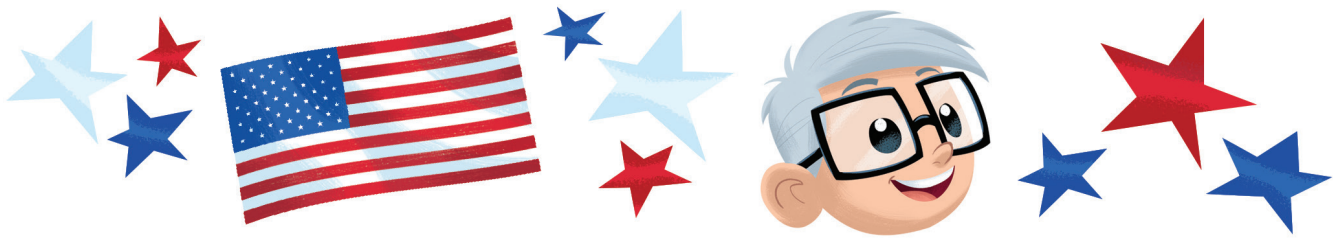
“Abraham was a great father, and so is my dad!”

“Happy Father’s Day! **Ruff Ruff!**”



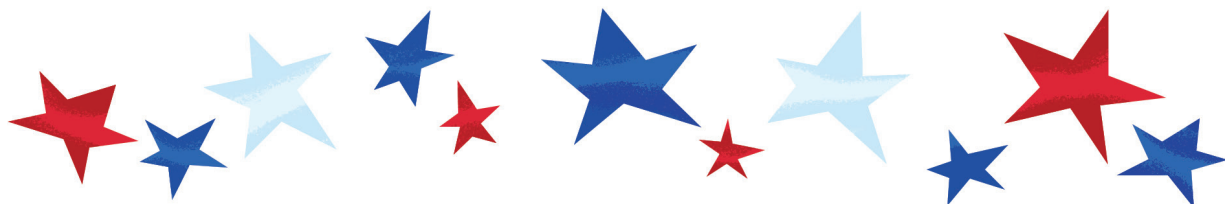
# We Love Our History

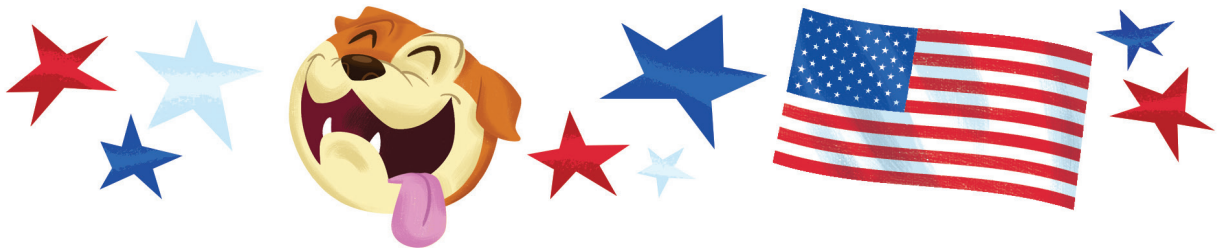
**Father's Day:** A holiday in which Americans recognize the contributions of fathers to their families and the country. It was started by a woman from Washington state named Sonora Smart Dodd in 1910. She wanted to recognize the impact her own father, William Smart, had on her life.

**Abraham:** A biblical figure who lived around 2000 B.C. According to the Bible, God called Abraham to be the father of His special, chosen people. When Abraham was about 100 years old, God promised to give him a son and that he would have many descendants. Abraham believed in God and was rewarded when God kept all of His promises and gave Isaac to him as a son.

**Isaac:** Abraham and Sarah's first son. Like his father, Abraham, he is remembered as one of the Fathers of God's people.

**Sarah:** Abraham's wife and Isaac's mother. She was about 90 years old when God promised she would have a child. Even though she was well past the age most women have children, the Bible teaches that God blessed her and she gave birth to Isaac.





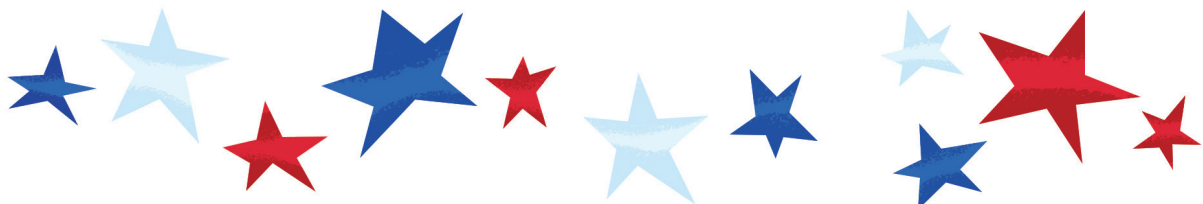
**Faith:** Belief or trust in something, especially in God and His promises.

**Pacific:** The largest and deepest ocean in the world, located between Asia in the west, and North and South America in the east.

**Second World War:** The war that took place from 1939-1945 involving many of the world's most powerful countries. During the war, the Allies, led by the United States, the United Kingdom, and Russia, defeated the Axis, led by Germany, Japan, and Italy.

**Sacrifice:** To give something up for others or for a cause.

**Navy:** The military service that performs operations on or under water. The U.S. Navy, formed in 1775, often uses battleships, aircraft carriers, and submarines to carry out its missions.

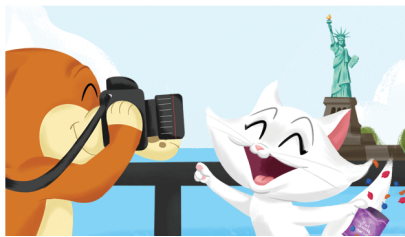

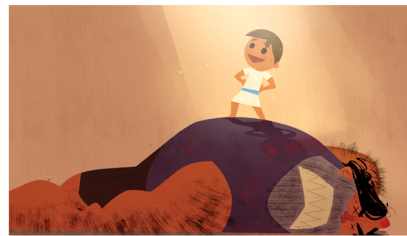
