As Patriotic Songs Fade From Classrooms, PragerU Kids Launches New Sing-Along Series Ahead of America’s 250th Anniversary

LOS ANGELES — PragerU Kids is launching “America’s Favorite Music Show,” a brand-new sing-along series for children ages 4 to 7 celebrating the people, places, stories, and songs that have shaped America. At a time when many schools no longer teach the beloved American standards that once connected young children to the country’s history and heritage, the series aims to help a new generation discover the music that has accompanied America’s story. Hosted by Jill Simonian, director of outreach for PragerU Kids, the show premieres Wednesday, June 17, introducing young viewers to American history through song and highlighting the symbols and themes that make our country unique.

Each episode follows Jill and her co-hosts, Revere, Abigail, and Mr. Miller, as they discover the songs that have helped tell America’s story—from iconic favorites such as “America the Beautiful” to military anthems like “The Wild Blue Yonder” and folk classics such as “I’ve Been Working on the Railroad.”

Episodes also include “The Star-Spangled Banner,” “You're a Grand Old Flag,” “My Country, 'Tis of Thee,” “The Army Goes Rolling Along,” “Anchors Aweigh,” “Home on the Range,” “Whoopie Ti Yi Yo (Git Along, Little Dogies),” “Red River Valley,” “Drill, Ye Tarriers, Drill,” “Low Bridge,” “Everybody Down (Fifteen Miles on the Erie Canal),” “Oh! Susanna,” “My Bonnie,” “Daisy Bell (Bicycle Built for Two),” and more!

“As a mom, I am thrilled and thankful to bring this show to life during a time when too many schools and communities have abandoned teaching our children patriotic songs that connect us to each other and to America’s past,” says Jill Simonian, director of outreach for PragerU Kids, host, and co-creator of “America's Favorite Music Show.”

“Music unifies us all—across perspectives and ages. We have a beautiful opportunity to find our way back to each other again, as Americans, through the songs that have connected generations,” Jill says.

The series debuts as the nation prepares to commemorate its 250th anniversary. By introducing children to the songs, stories, and traditions that have long been part of America’s shared cultural experience, this vibrant, educational series aims to cultivate early music, cultural literacy, and historical curiosity through storytelling and song, reinforcing messages of unity, freedom, civics, and sacrifice.

“America’s Favorite Music Show” is an original production of PragerU, created entirely in-house. The puppets were designed and crafted by members of the PragerU Kids production team, the set was built from scratch, and all voice actors are real people—not AI-generated.

Accompanying the series is the *America’s Favorite Music Show Songbook*, a richly illustrated companion that tells the story of each song featured in the show—tracing its history and cultural impact on Americans across 250 years. The songbook includes a historical narrative for every song, including lyrics and sheet music, giving families and educators a complete resource to bring America’s musical heritage to life.
