“Fox, look!”



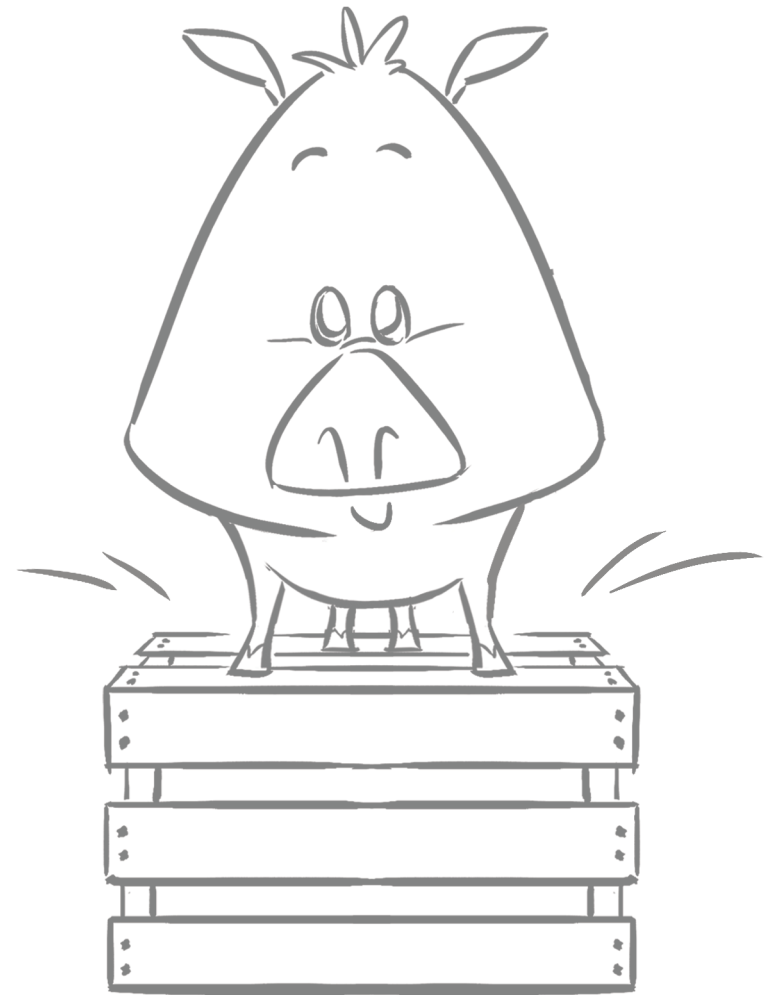
Bob the hog hops.

Bob is on a box!



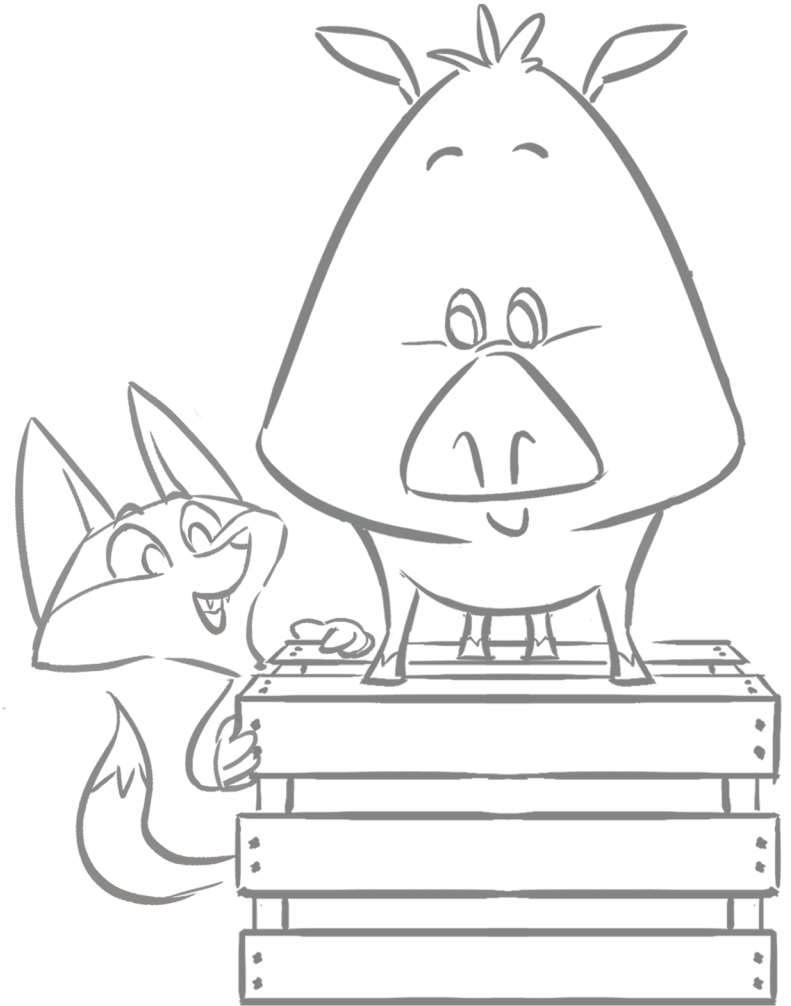
Fin the fox hops to

Fin the fox.



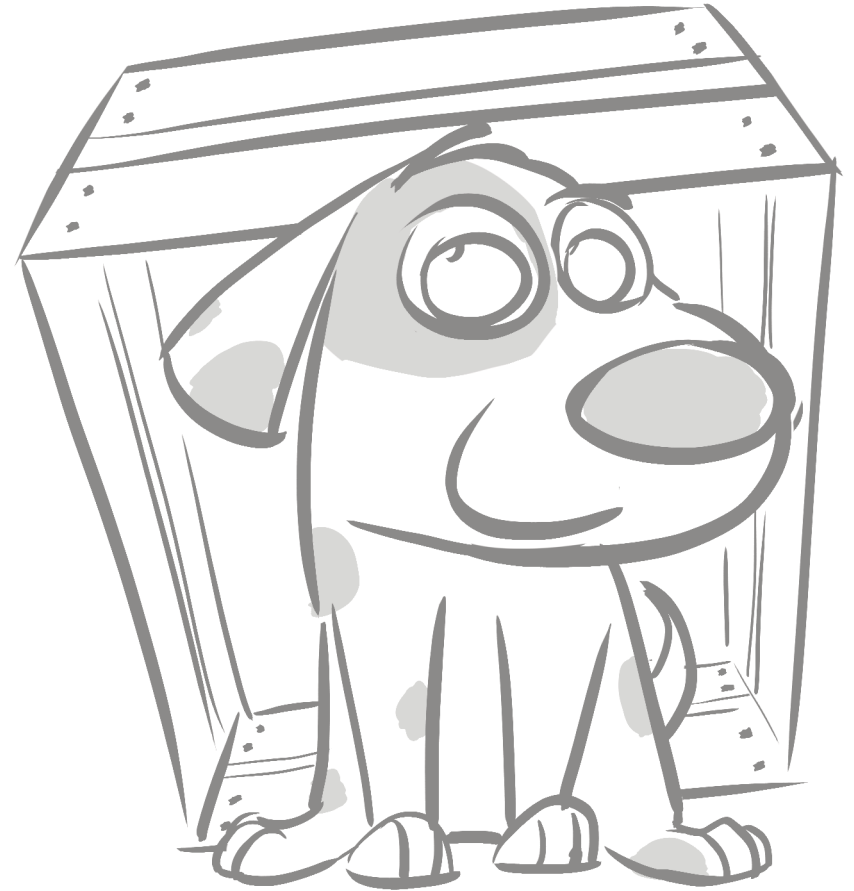
Bob hops and hops!

see the dog!



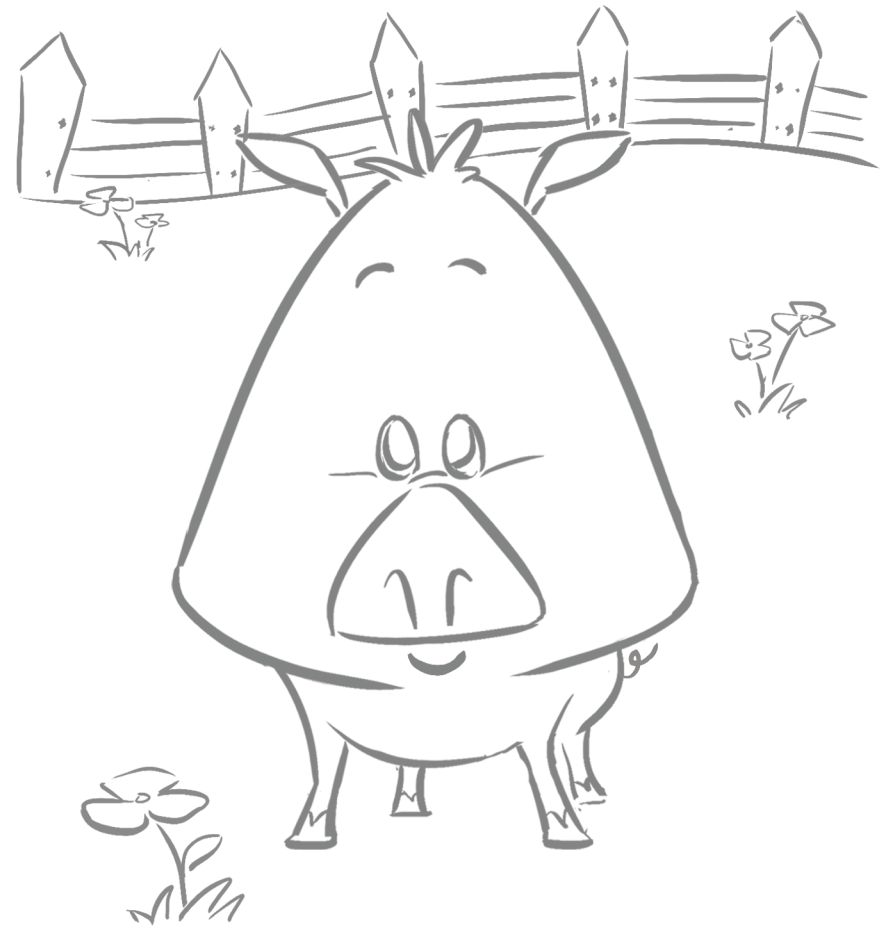
“Dog? Dog?”

said Fin the fox.



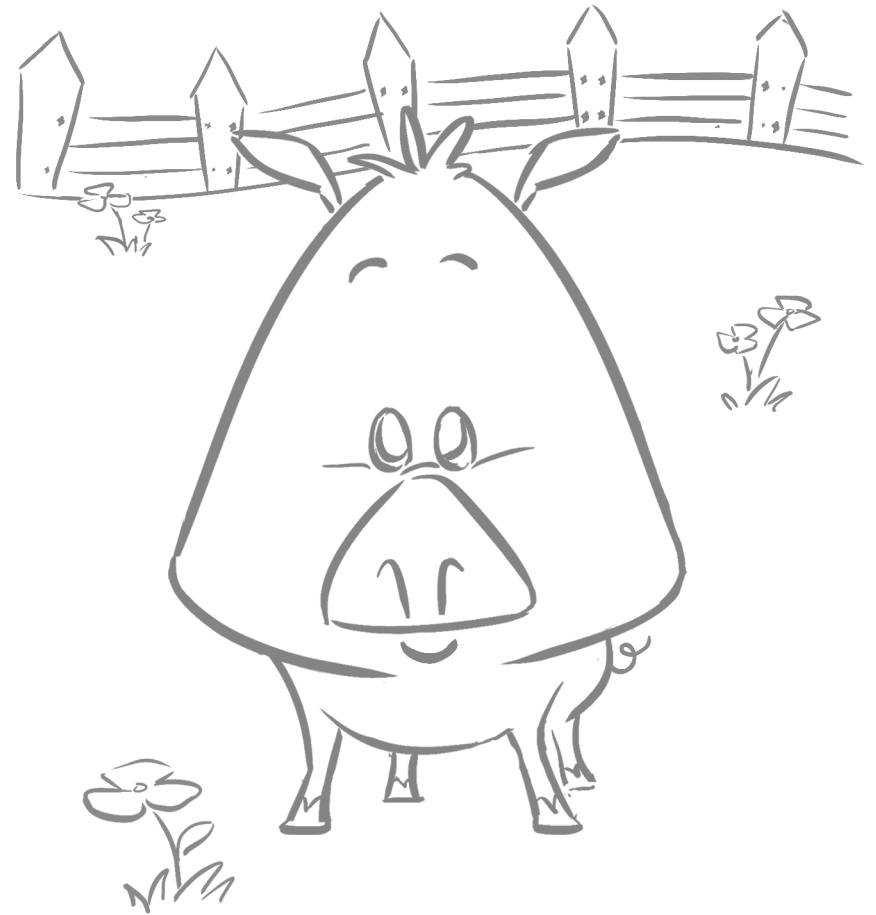
The dog is in the lot.

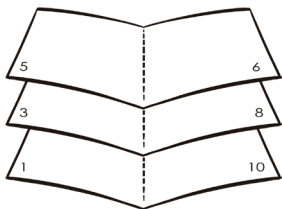

1. Stack



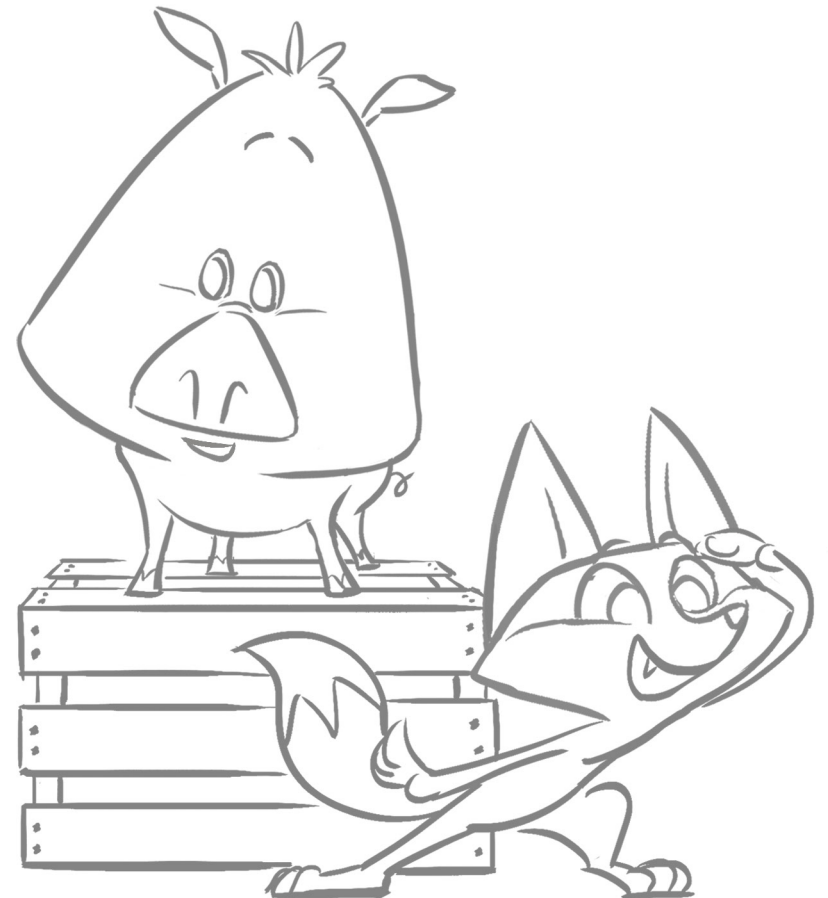
2. Staple
