path.”



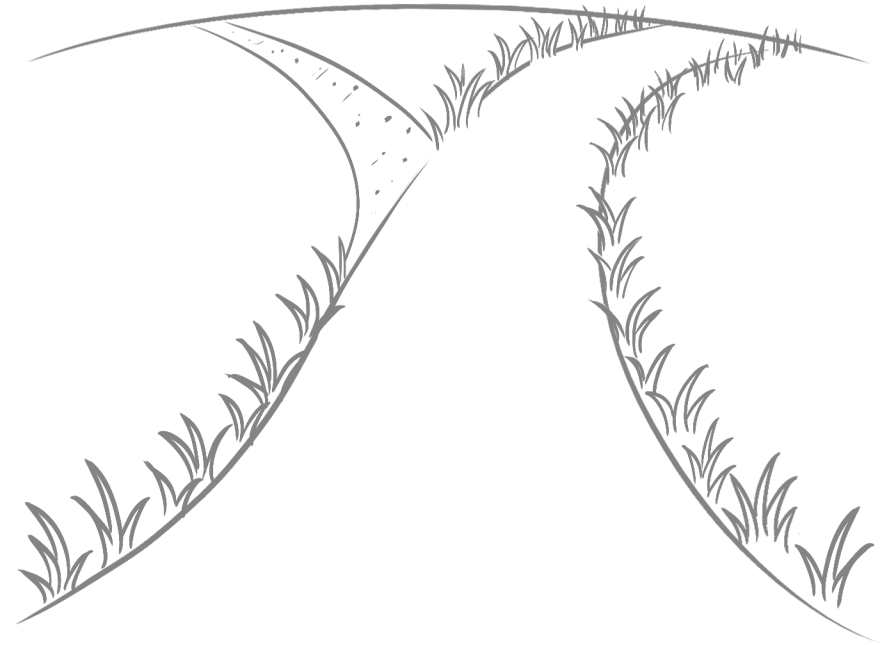
“It looks so fun!”

Beth.



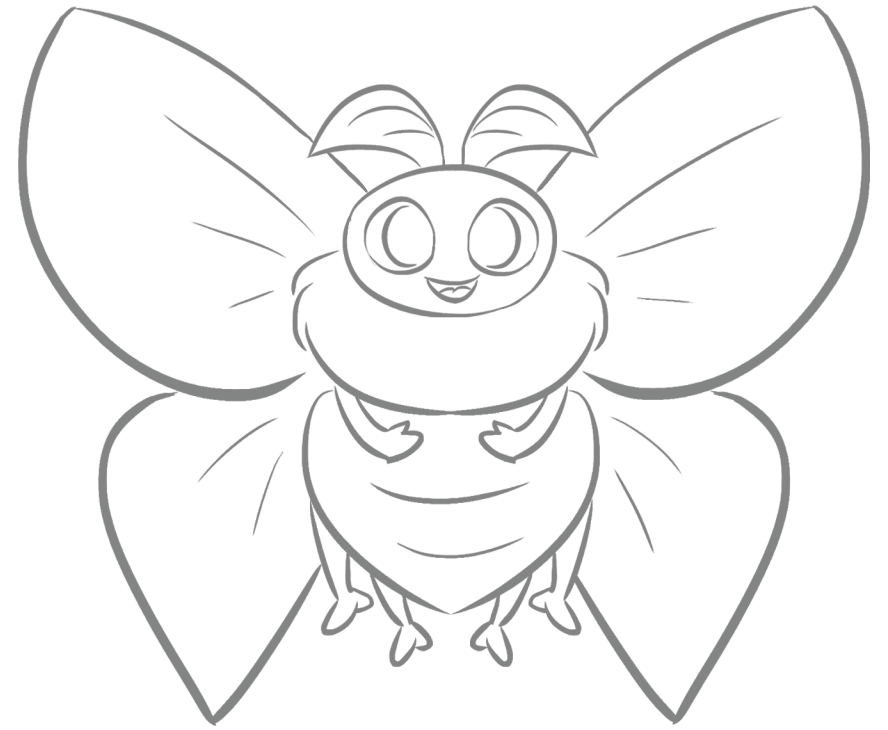
The moth is on a big

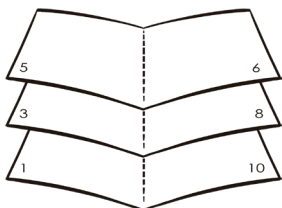
